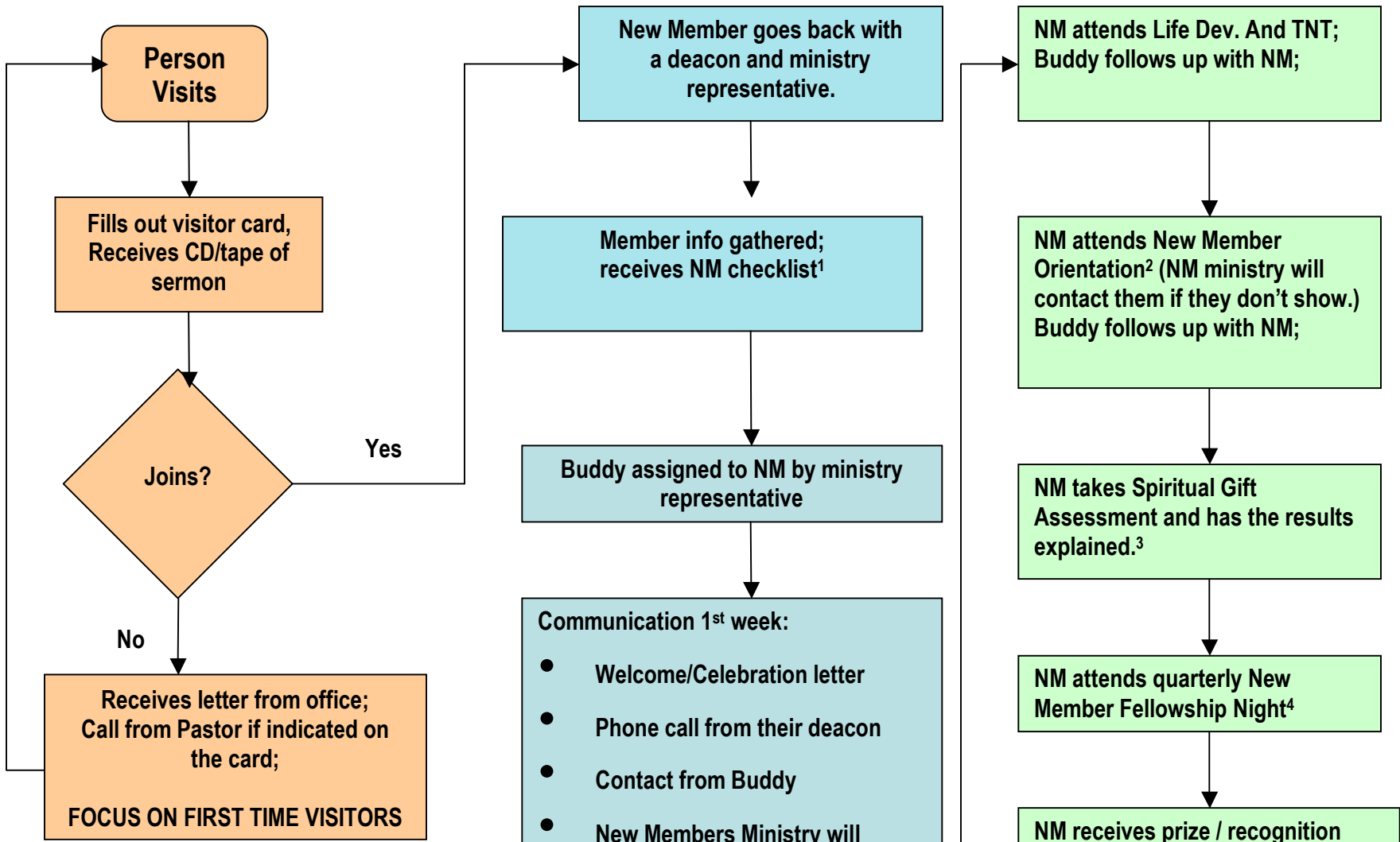


New Members Assimilation Flow



¹New Member Checklist
The checklist will guide new members on what steps they need to take after joining. It will be on cardstock paper, approx. 4" X 11". Each item will have a place for a signature for signoff, the requirement and a scripture to support it. The items are listed below:

1. Receive salvation & join the church family of United Believers Community Church
2. Attend New Members Orientation and receive a certificate for completion. (New Members Ministry Leader: Dec. Edward Newsome 816 941 4333)
3. Schedule and take the Spiritual Gifts Assessment. The assessment can be taken at the church in the computer lab on the upper level on Tuesdays and Thursdays from 4 PM – 6 PM (special scheduling available upon request). Contact Ms. Barbara Wiggins @ 816 966 9857 or Ms. Betty Hardin @ 816 868 6811 to schedule your assessment or for more information.
4. Attend and complete a life development class of your choice or attend traditional Sunday school class.
5. Attend and complete a life development class of your choice or attend traditional Sunday school class.
6. Attend TNT on a regular basis (discretion of the Pas if your attendance is regular)
7. Attend New Member Fellowship Night (BONUS)

²New Member Orientation (NMO)

1. A set schedule will be made.
2. The church's purpose statement needs to be given and discussed
3. Ministry info that includes leader's pictures with contact info given.
4. Deacon info that includes their pictures and contact info given.

Communication 1st week:

- Welcome/Celebration letter
- Phone call from their deacon
- Contact from Buddy
- New Members Ministry will contact them about NMO

Communication 2nd week:

- Buddy will seek NM out during service / answer questions
- Buddy will encourage NM to attend TNT and Life Dev.
- Buddy will verify that NM was contacted the previous week by church, deacon, and NM ministry

Deacon will contact NM at least once every 2 months.

³Spiritual Gifts Assessment (SGA)

1. A spiritual gifts lab will be held in the computer lab of the church on Tuesdays and Thursdays from 4PM – 6PM by appointment only
2. The lab will be run by Barbara Wiggins and Betty Hardin
3. Betty and Barbara will contact NMs who have completed NMO to schedule a time for them to take the SGA
4. The lab will also be open to other members who would like to take the SGA

⁴New Member Fellowship Night

1. To be held once a quarter on Friday Night from 6:30 PM – 7:30 PM
2. Will give NMs an introduction to the church and ministries.
3. NMs will have a chance to get questions answered.

⁵New Member Checklist rewards

1. After 3 items are completed the NM will receive a ribbon
2. After the remaining 3 items are completed the NM will receive a certificate with recognition.
3. If they attend the NM Fellowship night and complete the checklist there will be a bonus reward.
4. A survey / evaluation will be given to the NM after they complete the checklist in order to find out how they see the church and whether or not they have become involved.
